INSTRUCTIONS FOR USE

FOR USE ONLY AS AN AMATEUR LAWN TREATMENT. READ ALL SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS BEFORE USE. Keep children and pets away from treated areas until dry. To avoid drift, do not apply in windy conditions.

Maximum individual dose: 50 mL product per 25 m². Maximum number of treatments: 2 per year.

WHEN TO USE



Use from April to September on lawns that are actively growing.

For best results following application, do not cut grass for at least one day after treatment. Avoid application in drought or frost. To avoid drift, do not apply in windy conditions.

DO NOT USE ON NEW-SOWN LAWNS FOR AT LEAST SIX MONTHS AFTER ESTABLISHMENT. Re-treatment may be necessary for well-established difficult to control weeds. Allow an interval of at least 6 weeks between treatments.

WHERE TO USE

FOR USE ON LAWNS, for the control of most common broad-leaved lawn weeds. Including the problem weeds such as Clover, Daisy, Dandelion, Plantain and Common Chickweed.

HOW TO USE

SHAKE WELL BEFORE USE AND USE MIXTURE IMMEDIATELY.

We recommend wearing waterproof gloves and gardening footwear.



1. Use either a clean garden sprayer or watering can fitted with a fine rose.



2. Mix well before use. Loosen measure cap slightly, gently squeeze bottle until required volume is achieved.



- 3. Apply Weedol^{® LN Conc} Lawn Weed Control Concentrate at rate of 50 mL in 5 litres of water to cover 25 m² covering vegetation evenly. Hold the sprayer or watering can rose approximately 50 cm away from the target weed and lightly wet the weeds - avoid run-off. Direct away from ponds and other surface water bodies.
- 4. Wash hands after use. Wash equipment thoroughly after use.

CAUTION

Avoid spray coming into contact with cultivated plants.

The first 4 mowings of treated grass must be composted for 6 months before use as mulch. DO NOT dispose of grass clippings via council composting schemes. Scorching of grass can occur if product is over applied. Control may be reduced if rain falls within 24 hours of application.
